Entry rules and criteria

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Please note: By signing the entry form you are agreeing to the rules stated and to ensure that you follow good food safety and hygiene practice whilst preparing and transporting your entry/ies.

1. Each entry must be the sole unaided work of the person who's details are on the entry form, with exception to the under 16's category where guidance and support required for safety purposes is accepted assistance.

2. Novelty Cake: "TV & Cinema"

To enter this category the cake must be decorated in a "TV/ Cinema" theme. Not in excess of 2 tiers. The entry must be displayed on a disposable plastic/paper plate or cake board.

To be judged on taste as well as looks

2. Six Decorated Cupcakes:

To enter this category the cupcakes must be the same size and follow a chosen theme of own choice. They need to be on a disposable plastic/paper plate or cake board.

To be judged on taste as well as looks

3. Chocolate Cake/Bake

To enter this category the cake/bake must be chocolate flavoured. The entry must be on a disposable plastic/paper plate or cake board.

To be judged on taste as well as looks.

4. Under 10's: 3 x decorated cupcakes

To enter this category the entrant must be no older than 10 years old on the day of event and all work must be of their own doing (only adult supervision is allowed). The cupcakes must displayed on a disposable plastic/paper plate or cake board.

To be judged on taste as well as looks

5. 11 - 16's 3 x Cupcakes

To enter this category the entrant must be no older than 16 years old on the day of event and all work must be of their own doing (only adult supervision is allowed). The cupcakes must displayed on a disposable plastic/paper plate or cake board.

To be judged on taste as well as looks

6. Entry method and costs:

Entry via post or in person to Hope Hub or Skills4Living. Email entries to: info@skills4living.co.nz

Only one person per entry form, however individuals may

enter a category as many times as they wish. To enter it costs \$5 for each individual entry , \$2 for every 11 - 16s entry by the same person. Under 10s can enter any of the 5 categories they wish (at the same costs stated above), however the "Under 10's" category is FREE

7. What time does it start?

The doors will be open for you to bring your cakes and register your bakes from 08:00 till 9:30am. After this time the judging will start so the display area will be "out of bounds".

The winners will be announced at 2-2:30pm (along with prize giving).

8. What will the cakes and bakes be judged on?

The cakes will be judged on a number of points including the taste, techniques and skills involved to make them.

Please note the judges decision will be final

9. Where is it?

The competition is being held at **Hope Hub, 3 Kent Street, Levin, 5510** with good free local parking.

10. All entrants have the option of donating their cake to be sold for the raising of funds, and will be asked on the day.
