

Horowhenua Christmas Parade 2024 Float Competition Terms and Conditions

Competition

- Three (3) judges who select first, second and third places based on the judging criteria sheet, select winners. The criteria sheet is given to the appointed judges just prior to Christmas Parade commencing.
- Judges are representative from Horowhenua District Council, agencies associated with the 2024 Christmas Parade and/or hosts or MCs of the event.
- Every float that participates in the Horowhenua Christmas Parade is eligible.
- Every entrant warrants that all information submitted is true, current and complete. Horowhenua District Council reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who does not comply with these terms and conditions, and the 2024 Christmas Parade Health & Safety Plan.
- Competitions are open to Horowhenua District residents. Float Organisers must be aged 18 years and over, unless otherwise stated.
- A float can only enter once.
- Horowhenua District Council is the Organiser of these Promotions, they are not in any way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with, Facebook, Instagram or Twitter.
- You agree to release Facebook, Instagram or Twitter from any and all claims and demands arising out of, or in connection with, your participation in any of these Promotions or with any of the Prizes offered.

Entries, selection and prizes

- If you are the winner of a competition, Council will make reasonable efforts to contact you within 5 days of the draw using the contact details provided in your registration form. If for any reason Council is unable to contact you within that period then the prize will be forfeited and another winner drawn in your place on the same terms and conditions as the original draw.

Subject to any applicable laws which cannot be excluded, Council, its employees and agents will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury of any nature incurred or suffered by any person (including but not limited to direct or consequential loss or loss arising from negligence) arising directly or indirectly out of or in connection with any Competition or with winning, redeeming or benefiting from the prize

Privacy

Council may request to take a photo of the prize winner to be used for promotional purposes.
