Thank you for your letter received on 21 November 2023 requesting under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA), information relating to domestic water carriers. Please see outlined below a response to each part of your request.

***In the past 12 months can you supply me the total m3 of water that has been sold to domestic water carriers in your council area.***

Horowhenua District Council (the Council) supplies water at a designated filling station at Hokio Beach Road for a variety of purposes, including drinking water, cleaning, drilling, dust control, hydroseeding, hydrovac, livestock, rural fire, and swimming pools.

The total amount of water supplied from the filling station over 12 months is 4,636m<sup>3</sup>, of which 2,650m<sup>3</sup> was solely for drinking water from domestic water carriers.

***Whats the charge rate per m3 that domestic water carriers pay, and where is the supply point for loading***

There is a \$200 application fee and \$8 per load plus \$1.71/m<sup>3</sup>. The supply point for loading is at 122 Hokio Beach Road.

***Who are the verified domestic water carriers in your council area***

Council's verified domestic carriers are Aquagold Water Supply, Bulkwater, Clean Water Solutions, Waterfall Water Supply, and JB's Environmental.

***Can you supply me the towns or settlements in your council area who don't have a council supplied scheme***

Waitarere Beach, Hokio Beach, Waikawa Beach, and Manakau do not have a Council supplied scheme.

***Can you supply me a map of your council area***
