Thank you for email of 12 February 2024 requesting under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA), information relating to. Please see outlined below a response to each part of your request.

Does the settlements of Foxton Beach have a Council supplied water supply or does it rely on tank water /water carriers

Foxton Beach is supplied by two bores and the network is made up of 29.3km of mains and 14.1km of laterals. In all, Horowhenua District Council (the Council) supplies water to 1,600 properties in Foxton Beach. In summer, the population swells, leading to higher demand for water so restrictions are put in place to manage the demand.

Can you supply the m3 of water that have been sold to domestic carriers from August 2023 to January 2024

In relation to Foxton Beach, no water has been sold to domestic carriers from August 2023 to January 2024.
