The water meter project is a capital investment that is funded through Council borrowings. Targeted rates for water supply funds the cost of operating and maintaining the supply of reticulated drinking water to various communities within the District.

Please find attached employee numbers from January 2014 – February 2024. Actual salary and wage costs for each financial year is reported in our <u>Annual Reports</u>.
