Thank you for your email dated 5 January 2025 requesting under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA), information relating to housing needs and developments in the Horowhenua. Please see outlined below a response to each part of your request.

## Data on local housing demand, including any assessments of homelessness or housing shortages in the area.

Central Government ministries and agencies collect data on housing demand, capacity, shortages and homelessness. More information can be found on the websites for <u>Ministry of Social Development</u>, or <u>Ministry of Housing and Urban Development</u>.

## Insights into local partnerships or programs to address housing challenges.

Council has convened a developer's forum which includes for-profit and not-for-profit members. The forum meets periodically to discuss progress in addressing challenges around housing in the district.
