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Community Housing Consultation - Hearing of Submissions

1. Purpose

The purpose of this report is to receive and hear the submissions related to Council's special consultation process relating to an Amendment to the Long Term Plan 2015-2025 via its Community Housing Proposal.

2. Recommendation

- 2.1 That Report 16/126 on Community Housing Consultation Hearing of Submissions be received.
- 2.2 That this matter or decision be recognised as not significant in terms of s76 of the Local Government Act 2002.
- 2.3 That submissions 1 20 be received to the Amendment to the Long Term Plan 2015-2025.

3. Background/Previous Council Decisions

- 3.1 Council resolved to go out for special consultation with its community on a Community Housing proposal. A comprehensive Communications and Engagement Plan was developed which included engaging widely with both tenants and key stakeholders.
- 3.2 Council also sent information to Community Housing Providers making them aware of the current consultation period, seeking information as to the level of interest on such a proposal. Council has received a large amount of positive interest to this proposition.
